

Artist Fellowships

Artist Fellowships are highly competitive awards to creative artists in fourteen different arts disciplines (seven in each year) awarded solely on independent peer panel assessment of artistic quality taken from work samples submitted. The process is anonymous. The awards may be used to support the professional development of the artist. This program is carried out in partnership with the Mid Atlantic Arts Foundation.

Eligibility Criteria

Persons eligible for fellowships are:

- Artists who are permanent residents of the state of New Jersey (all awards are subject to verification of New Jersey residency).
- Artists who received fellowships five years earlier (recipients must wait five years before they can receive another fellowship).
- Artists who are NOT matriculated students in a graduate, undergraduate or high school program at the time of application or award (fellowships may not provide funding for scholarships or academic study in pursuit of a degree).
